

RCM REPORT

6/27/18

Stacey & I were both out of town for the last Regional & we tried several members of the NEFA board but it ended up no one could go. I contacted the Regional to properly advise them. April (our Secretary) posted our minutes on line & I used them, plus added info on World, etc.

Region was on 6/9/18. 8 of the 10 Areas were present (missing us & Ocean Gateway). Several positions, for various reasons, were appointed by the Chair of Region (Christian): Larry (Baltimore & former Chair of the Region) as Vice Chair, who will also fill in for Policy Chair, which was briefly vacant; PR was open & our current RD, Craig was appointed. Katie, current Literature Vice Chair, has moved up to Chair. August is elections, so all positions are open except RD, which Trisha, our RDA, will move into.

NEFA donation: Remember the \$220 from February in question that was an open check our Treasurer advised wasn't cashed? I asked our Regional Treasurer & Vice but they do not have the check. I recall the check & can see it in my mind but I think I accidentally tore it up with the reimbursement checks (from RCM report copies). I started a new practice of tearing up my reimbursement checks once I scan them. So, since it is nowhere to be found, I think it was torn. This turned out well because we were concerned about NEFA funds & will not need to be deducted from our books. **NEFA's donations/Phone line: We have paid Jan, Feb, March's Phone line.**

RD: (Craig): See reports. **INSPECTION:** See VERY GOOD report on line for the FLA motion (inspection). There were 12 concerns: see bullet points – 1st sentence in RD's report that states the allegation. Then, each item is addressed. The inspection took 2 days & found minimal results. PER Secretary's summary in the minutes: "Most of the problems stemmed from miscommunication & wild gossip." The inspection is done & both FLA & WSO feel the issues are settled. Recommendations are all on the report.

RDA: (Trisha): talked about the World Convention event (see below) & the Zonal meeting coming up next January in our Zone (Autonomy Zone) & how to stimulate interests.

Subcommittees: H&I/ Phone Line/ Literature/ PR / Special Events: See reports. 83 out of 91 shifts are filled on Phone Line Literature has a Chair now & PR is being chaired by our RD since he has a passion for PR. Special Events: report conflicts with minutes so I will get that updated. NEFA's events are noted.

AD HOC: committee for BUDGET – continues. Will follow.

FSRCNA: no one showed from the Convention committee. Vice Chair showed in May (to bring a flyer) but no one showed in April (last on-month). This is a concern due to the motion (see below) concerning money. This committee needs support for the 2019 Region Convention.

OLD BIZ:

- Zonal: talked about Zonal forum & who can actually be on the forum, yet all are welcome to attend the Zonal meeting in Jan.
- Speaker Jam: to get more people involved in service. More to come. Send ideas to Special Events Chair, Tina.

NEW BIZ:

- MOTION: (Susquehanna & Bay): To hold donations to world until further direction from RCM's. PASSED/ Unanimous.

Intent: to gather information about potential learning days and possible help to FSRCNA

I have discussed this with the Regional Chair last night. I would not necessarily agree with this motion since the past 3 months, only 1 month did someone show up to Region. I will follow at off-month.


